Outline of Course

The Swiss Nanoscience Institute (SNI) and NCCR Nanoscale Science and Technology have been offering ½ day courses in collaboration with the IAEME in applied ethics and science as part of the NCCR Module "Supplementary Research Activities" since 2005.

It has been decided to structure these courses – one half-day is held each semester - as Part 1 and Part 2. Part 1 (to be held each summer semester) will provide an introduction to applied ethics and the ethics of science.

The course will comprise frontal-interactive inputs, and case discussions.
